

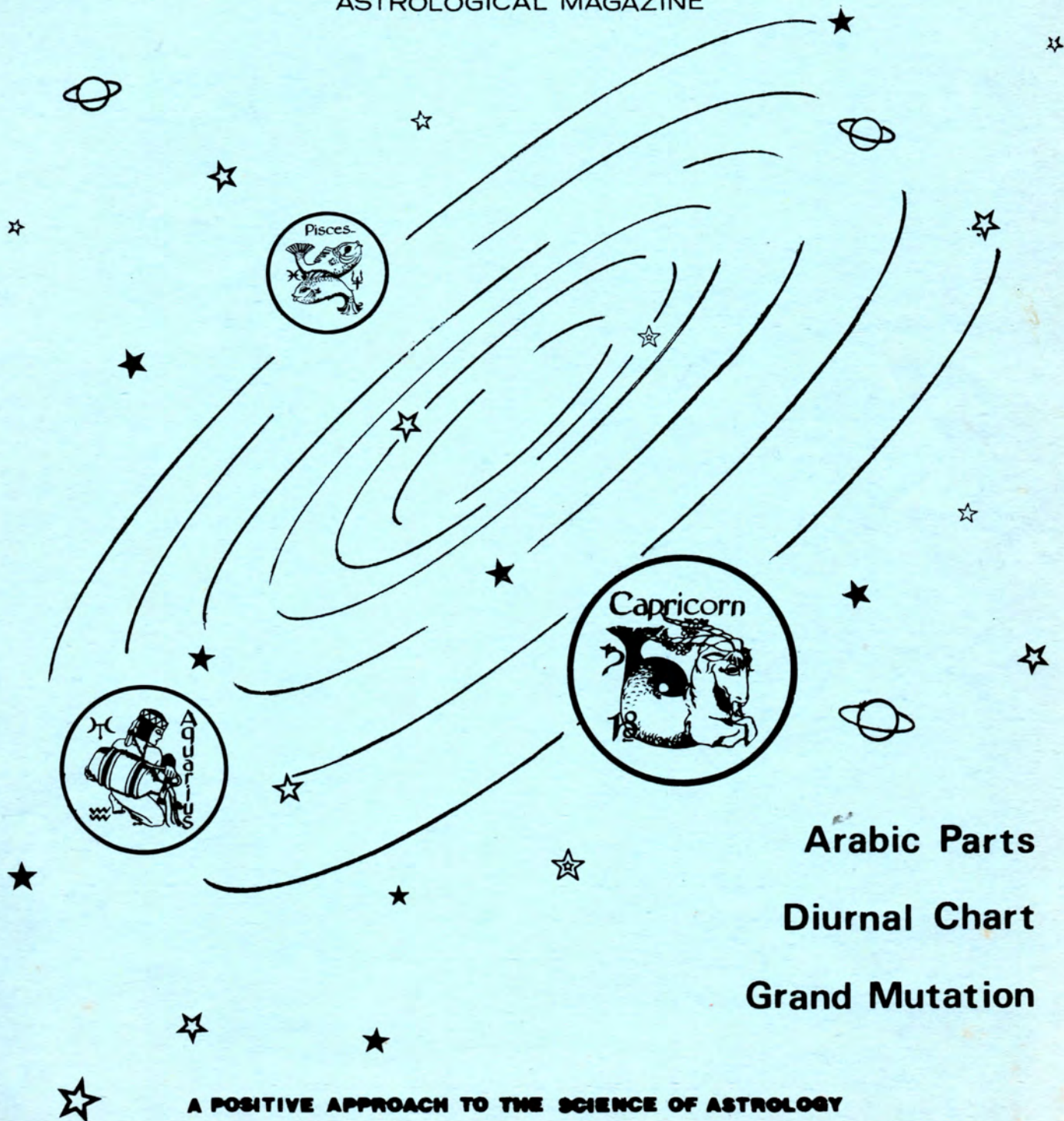

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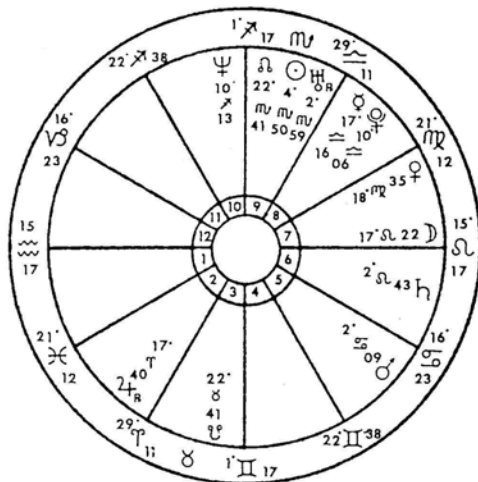

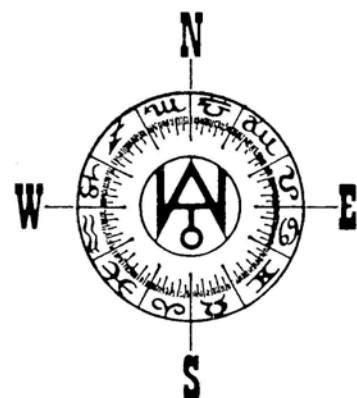
SWAC 1980

The 1980 SOUTH-WESTERN ASTROLOGY CONFERENCE was a big success; to prove it, some of ASPECTS' reviewers gave the following critiques --

KARMA WELCH wrote: " Santa Ana was the place to be on Oct. 16, 17, 18 and 19, 1980, where the 7th Annual SWAC was held.

"'Electrical energy'; 'best information yet'; 'warm and loving group participation'; 'and a well organized faculty,' were the most often heard phrases from not only those attending for the first time, but also from many of the 'old faithfuls.

"All luncheon and dinner speakers were good - with Carol Rushman taking top honors in popularity, and for holding the attention of the audience.



" On the negative side were complaints about the Ramada Inn: delays due to slow elevators; though the food was good, it took a long time to serve and sometimes it ran out; meeting places in the lobby and bar were not as good as the Holiday Inn, Buena Park, where the conference had been held for several years.

"The 'cycles of life' are obvious to the person who attends SWAC yearly. As the renewal of friendship is on a once-a-year basis with those many people who continue to attend, the physical changes in size and shape, the new personality traits, the new levels of understanding, and the many growth patterns--not only in these individuals, but as well in their selection of partners and friends--stick out like sore thumbs. Some are good changes; others are not so good.

" The cycles turn before our eyes; a cycle of growth is followed by a cycle of decline; some are on the up-swing, and some are winding down, ready to begin anew. 'Cycles,' by the way, is the theme for the 1981 SWAC in November. See you there!"

PHILIP SEDGWICK from behind-the-scenes: "I must concede, with my involvement in the coordination of SWAC, on behalf of the San Diego Astrological Society, that my opinion of the conference is rather subjective. We had a record attendance which seemingly outgrew the new location in its initial year. The facilities provided excellent food, some of the best I've ever had at a conference. All confusion surrounding the mealtimes appears to have been a function of not having had expected such a crowd --that's not a complaint-- we were glad to see everyone. Many of the faces were new and hailed from a variety of new locations.

"Likewise, we had some new speakers at SWAC, including Jay Jacobs, Carol Rushman, Stephen Connors and many others. The 'old favorites' also fortified the faculty, and presented their topics with enthusiasm and quality. There were some speakers scheduled who could not attend the conference for a variety of reasons, however, we do look forward to having them come next year. Capricorn Ingress Chart

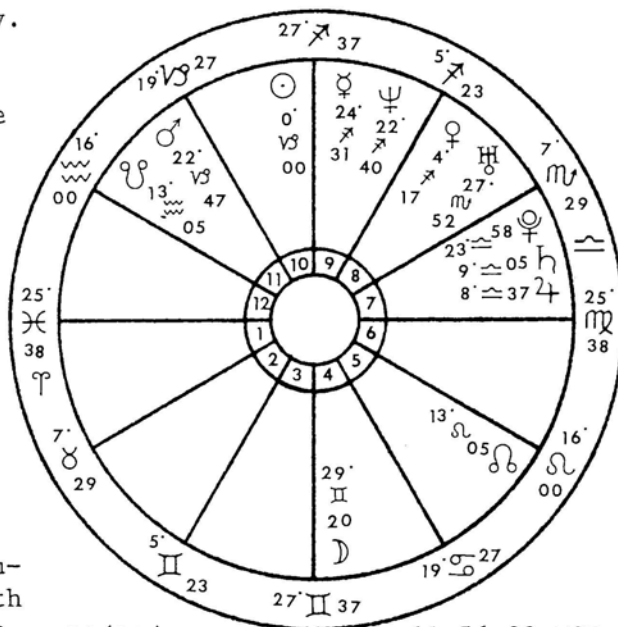
The final ingress of 1980 ushers in a whole new era in world consciousness as Jupiter and Saturn are in conjunction at 9 degrees of Libra. This major conjunction of the two largest planets of our solar system is called the Great Mutation. The entire cycle encompasses 960 Years, and is divided into four 240 year epicycles, during which the conjunction tenants the same element. In all, there occur twelve synods of twenty years in each of the trigon. There are roughly forty-eight conjunctions in the entire grand cycle; in their course these planets tenant every one of the twelve signs. There is an increscent effect that lasts for 140 years after these planets first meet in an element, so there is an overlapping influence from each of the signs in the trigon.

After the fire trigon began Dec. 8, 1603 at 8° Sagittarius, North America began colonization which was partly due to the religious oppression at home. (Sagittarius) Following the Earth Trigon which began Jan. 26, 1842 at 9° Capricorn, there were great changes in the governmental organizations throughout the earth. Now the current Air Trigon began Dec. 31, 1980 at 9° Libra. This change of element is just beginning and does not become fully established in Air until 2080 when it occurs in Gemini. Mundane astrologers hope this conjunction signals in a new era of world communication, balance, fairness and organization. The conjunction's change from the materialistic earth to more the flexible and idealistic air should help to shape the course of history.

This chart shows the periodicity and gradual procession through the trigon of earth into that of air, though this does not become fully established until 2080 AD.

Washington, DC

The winter solstice chart for Washington D.C. finds the Sun in the tenth, opposed by the Moon in the fourth. Obviously indicating that the general public is very conscious of the new leadership, which they expect to put to the test. Mars

squares Pluto from the eleventh house sanctioning drastic changes. As this house rules congress generally, it is interesting to note that for the first time since 1954, Republicans control the Senate, and only five seats separate the House-250 Democrats to 245 Republicans. With Pluto coming from the seventh house and ruling the eighth, this square could also indicate more funding in order to beef up the military.

In the Jupiter/Saturn conjunction, Saturn is elevated over Jupiter, which proposes the death of an eminent man. As the conjunction is in a Cardinal sign, these effects are more immediately visible, (i.e. John Lennon).

The position of the Jupiter/Saturn in the seventh house will highlight international relationships, which can effect trade agreements. The elevated Mercury Neptune conjunction may confuse Commerce treaties and agreements, and there may be more problems connected with immigration. The Ascendant squared by its ruler Neptune, indicates something hidden or confusion connected with the democratic political movement.

Both of the lights, the Sun and Moon, will be eclipsed within thirty days of each other. Eclipses in fixed signs are normally followed by quakes, chiefly in areas where the eclipse is visible. The Solar Eclipse of Feb. 4-5 occurs mostly over the unpopulated areas of the Pacific Ocean.

With Neptune ruling the ascendant and in the ninth conjunction Mercury and semi-sextile Mars in the eleventh, ruler of the intercepted first, the United States government's aim may be to effect good and solid relationships with foreign countries, however, suspicion could arise as to the true motives and intentions of the United States government.†

Robert 'Buz' Myers is a professional astrology lecturer and counselor from South Euclid, Ohio, who specializes in Medical astrology. He has been on the ISAR and SWAC faculties and in October 1980 he spoke for Aquarius Workshops on 'Disconnected Planets'. The following article shows Mr. Myers versatility of understanding astrology as he explains the function of the Arabic Parts.

How To Calculate Your ARABIC PARTS

by Robert Myers

With the advent of the computer, astrologers have been given time to experiment with new ideas as well as an opportunity to reach back into astrological history to uncover systems that have lain dormant, and bring them into the 20th century. The Arabic Parts is a system which was devised by the Ancients and used to help find events and personality traits. When studied they give interpretation a new dimension, but are helpful only when used properly. To put all 34 Arabic Parts with the planets in a chart, and try to interpret the horoscope is useless, but the application of these parts to assist in answering specific questions is to put them to their most valuable purpose.

I have chosen to explore ten of these 34 Arabic Parts in detail, in the space available.

To calculate Arabic Parts, first convert the signs into numbers as follows:

♈ = 1	♌ = 7

PART OF FORTUNE ☉ Asc. + ♀ - ☺

In the Part of Fortune, we blend the physical body (ascendant) with the personality (♀) and remove the ego (☺). This is the natural Part of Fortune. It is man's ego that stands in the way of what he tries so hard to achieve. The Part of Fortune, as a matter of fact, can easily be a point of stress in a natal chart, for here is where one feels a great need to accomplish and strive to acquire dominance. The "fortune," therefore, is attained because one perseveres to balance the physical and emotional needs; the key is to not allow the ego to stand in the way.

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / ♀ : Success is found when the native understands how not to let his ego get in the way of physical and/or emotional needs.
- 2nd house / ☿ : The native's greatest fortune here is learning to enjoy the fruits of his labor; not just acquiring money but learning to enjoy that which it provides.
- 3rd house / ♀ : The acquiring of knowledge and learning to enjoy the giving of that knowledge through the art of communication brings fortune.
- 4th house / ☿ : A secure foundation is the key to good fortune; home, hearth, and family provide the native with his greatest rewards.
- 5th house / ♀ : Fortune is derived from developing creative ability and finding pleasure in the results, as well as learning to make it an important part of the native's profession.
- 6th house / ☿ : Health is fortune. Do not allow the ego to interfere with the service that must be given. When the native trusts his analyzing abilities fortune is sure to be the reward.
- 7th house / ♀ : Learn to balance in relationships with people and do not allow the ego to stand in the way; success comes through team effort.
- 8th house / ♀ : Fortune comes to the native through unlocking secret doors that expose the personality. Benefits are also derived with the use of the resources of others.
- 9th house / ♀ : Foreign lands bring fortune, as well, extending the intellect into higher-minded studies is of much benefit. Experiences in these two areas bring opportunities for prosperity.
- 10th house/ ☿ : Success in business and worldly matters come to the native when he learns to flow with life, not control it.
- 11th house/ ♀ : Sudden change brings success and with it comes great awareness. Openness to change helps one understand and plan for new reforms.
- 12th house/ ☿ : This is sometimes referred to as the "part of misfortune," because difficult situations force sacrifice on the part of the native. However, this placement is fortunate as it teaches sacrifice for the benefit of others rather than for the benefit of self.

PART OF LOVE Asc. + ♀ - ☉

Combining the physical body (Asc.) with the physical senses (♀) gives the ability to love on a sensual level. When the ego (☉), the will of the person, is subtracted, it allows one to feel and sense the kind of love which is most pleasurable. The Part of Love is where the urge to adapt oneself to others manifests in the chart and shows the nature of one's affections.

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / ♈ : The affections are strong and there is a need to feel pleasure in an active way. The changing energy of the love nature is in constant search to find self-love.
- 2nd house / ♎ : There is great pleasure in acquiring the sensuous things of life through the luxury of expensive clothes, elegant living and the pleasure of being "spoiled."
- 3rd house / ♊ : Considerable delight is derived from mental stimulation since love starts as a thought and leads to action. One's curiosity is stimulated to search for the true definition of love.
- 4th house / ♋ : The native is very sensitive, all love is experienced as tender in nature, and there is a love of domesticity, home and family.
- 5th house / ♌ : The recipe for the Part of Love in this position begins with the appeal of the drama of love; add a bit of luxury, a large amount of generosity and finally allow the heart to rule the head.
- 6th house / ♏ : This native loves pure beauty; pleasure is of a detached type which can lead to service in love.
- 7th house / ♍ : Love comes through harmony in all things. Tenderness is a must while fairness in sharing forms bonds for the native.
- 8th house / ♏ : Passion and possessiveness must fire love's energy as the native needs a great deal of sensation to find fulfillment in love.
- 9th house / ♏ : There is a love of studies that relate to the higher mind. One must have freedom to come and go as needed. The native enjoys high-spirited people who are adventurous.
- 10th house/ ♏ : Here is a love of excellence in all matters concerned with the love nature. A strong sensual tie is sought, as love needs to develop a state of self-reliance.
- 11th house/ ♏ : The native has a great need for intellectual companionship and delights in social life. This placement needs a partner who enjoys experimentation.
- 12th house/ ♏ : Here, the native creates an illusion and then makes it a reality. Therefore, one seeks a partner whose awareness fulfills his love nature.

PART OF PASSION

Asc. + ♄ - ☉

When the physical body (Asc.) is added to the passion, desire, energy, courage and initiative (♄) and the ego (☉) is put aside, one confronts his passionate nature. The sensual force of passion is brought to life at this point. Not only is it reflected in the sexual act but this energy can be released in many ways. To awaken the Part of Passion means to come alive and feel energy flow through oneself.

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / ♈ : A forceful attitude brings about the desired results. There is also a need to be independent and use daring methods to achieve goals.
- 2nd house / ♉ : Applying a calm, controlled use of energy allows the native to use earthly goods to develop his craftsmanship ability.
- 3rd house / ♊ : The native has a passion for communications - both written and verbal expression. Inspirational flashes lead to a search for the answers.
- 4th house / ♋ : There is a strong passion for emotional feelings. Though the energy is used very indirectly, it is used with great persistence. There is also a desire for security and for domestic comfort.
- 5th house / ♌ : The native is totally mobilized towards leadership, and there is a great passion for displays of this energy and creativity.
- 6th house / ♍ : Here, passion is disciplined towards service and there is a desire to achieve executive levels where the analytical logical side can be utilized.
- 7th house / ♎ : To be known as an expert, to be clever and skillful in a mental way is the passion of this position. There is the desire to handle awkward situations with ease and balance the energy.
- 8th house / ♏ : The passion to probe and investigate until discovery is achieved reflects the strong sensual nature that "one must win." There is great executive ability with a dedication to victory.
- 9th house / ♐ : The native has to follow impulses without interference and dislikes limitations. All outdoor activities are needed for full physical expression.
- 10th house/ ♑ : To bring all of life's goals efficiently to completion is this native's desire nature, as well as to be known as a responsible individual.
- 11th house/ ♒ : The native desires to achieve the scientific approach to life through a detached but humanitarian manner. There is a passion for the unusual or original.
- 12th house/ ♓ : Sometimes the energy is unstable here due to the need to feel all the impulses which are sent to the native. There is a desire to live out personal fantasies and being charitable also arouses the passions.

PART OF INCREASES Asc. + ♃ - ☉

Blending the physical body (Asc.) with expansiveness (♃) allows one to discover where or what can expand to increase wisdom. By subtracting the ego (☉) one allows the increase without ego limitations. The Part of Increase indicates one's expansion into wisdom, enthusiasm, benevolence and generosity - all things ruled by Jupiter.

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / ♈ : The individuality is increased through the discovery of the mind and thought processes which help one obtain his desire for freedom.
- 2nd house / ♎ : Increases come through the material side of life when used as a constructive force for self growth. Also, the native's pleasure nature will expand and add a strong charitable side to his life force.
- 3rd house / ♊ : Expansion is manifested through a need for education which can uncover a witty side of the personality. This can lead to becoming a "Jack-of-All-Trades...Master-of-None." There is as well an uncanny ability to effortlessly master many languages.
- 4th house / ♋ : Strong increases occur through the knowledge of food and the food industry. The native enjoys large families and has an awareness of emotions and sympathies which help to achieve a higher state of wisdom.
- 5th house / ♌ : The standard of living is increased as the native needs to express extravagances. The ego must expand itself for the native to achieve awareness. This individual also enjoys a humorous nature.
- 6th house / ♏ : Here there is a discriminating quality which allows wisdom to come through service and research. The individual has to become aware of his valuable analytic ability to fulfill his life function.
- 7th house / ♍ : The native increases through partnership and unions which add an artistic quality to the life. Expansion develops through a need to be harmonious and fair.
- 8th house / ♐ : This position expands the resourceful side of the native and adds magnetism and will power. There is a true desire to delve into the study of hidden laws.
- 9th house / ♏ : As the individual increases his knowledge and travel and active physical expression, he can then come in contact with his life force. Faith in all matters expands self into freedom.
- 10th house/ ♏ : Here the native increases the sense of duty and the feeling of ambition while expanding the organizing powers and thriftiness. Wisdom can be gained when a serious outlook is not overtaken by materialism.
- 11th house/ ♏ : This position increases humanitarian pursuits and reforms. Expanding into originality and imagination, brings wisdom to the mind; the native's true mission in life is to transmit this wisdom to the children of the world.
- 12th house/ ♏ : The native finds a sense of increase through charitable causes which allows him to utilize his psychic nature and to increase his power in the healing arts.

PART OF FATE

Asc. + ♄ - ☉

The combination of the physical body (asc.) with the crystallization, responsibility, justice, pessimism and caution (♄) while subtracting the will (☉), allows the native to experience fated action without the self interfering and Karma may be utilized as the will becomes helpless. The ancients felt this part showed fated lessons. Today there is a different understanding of the word fate, that all things lead to God; so through the action of the Part of Fate some of one's greatest responsibilities are worked out.

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / ♈ : Here self-reliance leads to self-sacrifice and fate brings some frustration. Thus the native tends to push, which causes problems in timing and manifests the Karma of frustration.
- 2nd house / ♎ : Fate brings a lack of spontaneity as the native does not know when to react. There is a fear of poverty and dependency and one's Karma is related to materialism.
- 3rd house / ♊ : There is a fear of restriction which directs the individual toward becoming more adaptable. The native can be calculating in nature and impulsive in behavior. There is a Karmic fear of learning.
- 4th house / ♋ : The native must develop a positive emotional attitude to overcome the Karmic fear of being emotionally vulnerable, as fate deals this individual a "pessimistic hand."
- 5th house / ♏ : The Karmic lesson is a fear of mediocrity as fate teaches the native humility and generosity which in turn help him to strive for honor.
- 6th house / ♏ : The native is obsessed with the Karmic worry of the unknown. The lessons here teach analytical ability and, in this manner, self confidence becomes a part of the nature, and faith a part of the spirit.
- 7th house / ♏ : Fate teaches judgment and the art of diplomacy, as the native encounters experiences about which he is not objective. Karma here is to learn to become involved on the deepest levels.
- 8th house / ♏ : The Karma of emotional dependency can be directed only when the native learns emotional control. Fate develops situations that teach flexibility and necessitate a forgiving nature.
- 9th house / ♏ : Fate inspires the native to find personal spirituality. Feeling constantly restricted, he fights for independence, thus his Karma is one of feeling constantly "fenced-in."
- 10th house/ ♏ : Here Karma is in the area of confidence, as fate places the individual in positions requiring perseverance. One is taught self-control along with the ability to wait for rewards.
- 11th house/ ♏ : Fate pushes gratitude on the native which helps him understand loyalty and the brotherhood-of-man concepts. There is a lack of initiative which creates the Karma of non-involvement.
- 12th house/ ♏ : Fate makes one use and trust the inner voice as it teaches compassion. A moody, indecisive nature is worked out after the Karma of "self-imprisonment" is handled.

PART OF CATASTROPHE

Asc. + ☿ - ☉

When the physical body (Asc.) connects with sudden change, revolution, originality, and inspiration (☿), one finds a sudden need to change the course of action. When will (☉) has been taken out of the way, these sudden events can happen without personal control. Each man needs to be put back on course now and then; he needs to be brought to a point where he can discover a new awareness about himself. To some people this would be interpreted as catastrophic as with the Ancients who lived in a caste system where evolution and originality were thought to be dangerous. Today we know that man grows through change but only when he is aware that the change leads to enlightenment.

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / ♀ : Abrupt changes in the life's direction cause the native to become independent and make him willing to become a leader.
- 2nd house / ♂ : Indecision is replaced by determination with sudden reversals in the monetary system. Catastrophe brings the awareness that security can be established with the constructive use of the native's energies.
- 3rd house / ♀ : Catastrophe strikes the nervous system with events that trigger a need to call upon the mental energies for ingenious answers.
- 4th house / ♂ : Unexpected happenings in the family destroy insensitive feelings and awaken one's loyalty and sharpen domestic impulses.
- 5th house / ♀ : Catastrophe hits the ego and reminds the native that he cannot be indifferent to others; this adds a dramatic sense which is inspirational.
- 6th house / ♀ : Awareness is reached through sudden upheavals in the body which teaches the native to purify his life.
- 7th house / ♀ : Revolutions of awareness are reached through relationships that teach compromise and the native is relieved of rigid attitudes.
- 8th house / ♀ : Catastrophe brings the need to suffer on the deepest levels, where it is transformed into a desire to regenerate and investigate the self through metaphysical pursuits.
- 9th house / ♀ : Sudden upheavals destroy the orthodox systems and in their place awakens courage to rebel in search of enlightenment.
- 10th house / ♀ : Awareness is brought about by sudden events that teach the native to become responsible. Catastrophe teaches the art of self-discipline and shrewdness.
- 11th house / ♀ : Sentimentality is smashed through sudden events; in its place emerges progressive thinking toward humanitarian ideals. Ideas and the urge to free mankind from ignorance manifest at this point.
- 12th house / ♀ : Unexpected changes in the material life make the native aware of compassion and the need to sacrifice. This position adds a strong impulse for religion.

PART OF TREACHERYAsc. + Ψ - $\odot$

Adding the physical body (Asc.) to imagination, intuition, limitless expansion, idealism, self-sacrifice, illusion and decay (Ψ) brings us ever closer to the realization that man is but an illusion, creating his own reality. The Part of Treachery is proof of this fact. When the will ($\odot$) is subtracted from this blend, man finds himself living his illusion without the power to change it. The illusion becomes the one he chose before he entered this life and the will is not allowed to alter it in any way. We should refer to this part as the reality of "self-treachery."

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / Υ : The native imagines his sense of a great mission in life which leads him to seek direct inspiration from the Divine. Radical ideas can also become fanatical ideals.
- 2nd house / δ : The feeling of a limitless desire to have all that the eyes behold creates losses of great value. A strong sensuous nature can be lifted and used for healing.
- 3rd house / Π : Self-treachery comes through the mind. Feeling what one wants as others speak it causes the native to be misled. One needs to-change worry into inspiration.
- 4th house / Σ : Imagination can play tricks on the abilities. One learns that there are both positive and negative forces working which will help the native rechannel his life force. This lifts self-indulgence towards social awareness.
- 5th house / Ω : Self-treachery comes through the need for flattery, egotism and power. Developing a strong intuition gives the native the ability to lead and inspire others. One must seek God in all.
- 6th house / ♁ : Searching for detail leads the native toward believing he is less than the whole. Treachery becomes a feeling that self is different from others. Turn to natural health and teach others what is learned.
- 7th house / ♊ : The loss of self through compromise is the native's self-treachery. Put self before others and allow the harmony in the nature to be used for humanitarian reasons.
- 8th house / ♋ : Sensation leads to perverse action. Secretive tendencies can create mistrust; transmute this energy into investigations of the occult.
- 9th house / ♌ : Here treachery is freedom, searching, higher knowledge and a lack of commitment. When the native uses his great philosophical ideas to inspire, the treachery becomes loyalty.
- 10th house / ♍ : An inflated sense of ambition brings open enmity. One should become contemplative about one's real role in life and always remember the people who have been of help.
- 11th house / ♎ : Treachery comes through one's detached attitude of needing to be independent which causes dependency. The real illusion is social and political independence for everyone.
- 12th house / ♏ : Treachery comes from a feeling nature which absorbs all things it contains. The native feels the "pain of mankind" which hinders him. The power to transmute suffering is possible only when the native learns that the pain is not meant for him personally.

PART OF ORGANIZATION

Asc. + ♀ - ☉

Blending the physical body (asc.) with regeneration, transformation, group power (♀) there is the ability to work with parts of the subconscious that have been dormant for long periods of time. The goal is to bring those subconscious parts to consciousness and organize them into the native's work personality. The Part of Organization destroys the old and then creates the new from the rubble. It relates to the group and the power that the group has over the native. By subtracting the will (☉) a condition is set up whereby the individual, at this point, chooses to step aside to allow the action to take place for the good of the whole. Through death there is life.

THROUGH THE HOUSES/SIGNS

- 1st house / ♀ : Subconscious feelings of raw power are transformed into working with group expression, so as to emancipate conditions in the world. Pulling this raw power up from the subconscious helps strengthen the group; holding in this raw power causes the group to attack the native.
- 2nd house / ♂ : Obsessions with unconscious materiality are transformed and brought to conscious awareness when the power of the group investing is studied and practiced. Deepseated sensual feelings can be lifted from the lower side of the nature and used in artistic endeavors.
- 3rd house / ♀ : Comprehension can be achieved through group disciplines. When the native lifts his restless energy, he can learn to balance it through yoga and other physical means. One can use the mind to help invent new ideas for group functions.
- 4th house / ♂ : Groups that teach awareness, psychic development and responsibility bring the native out of obsessions with security and steer him into emotional maturity. Groups involved with helping people who are emotionally locked into the past, transform the native into an emotional adult.
- 5th house / ♀ : Over-developed attitudes about self can be transformed by teaching people self-confidence through their creative nature. Group involvement draws the native's unconscious from concentrating on self into inter-relations with others; here a full creative self is discovered.
- 6th house / ♂ : Perfection is reached when unconscious attitudes of right and wrong are understood. The native's tendency is to feel that perfection is a state he has acquired without the rest of humanity. This will be transformed to "perfection is the creation" by working in group activities that serve mankind.
- 7th house / ♀ : Unconscious patterns of indecision leave the native hanging on the fence. Death of this pattern happens through groups that work to bring justice and beauty to mankind.
- 8th house / ♀ : The native feels "as if death were the answer, only to bring a new birth." Unconscious drives to burn one's bridges and end matters are transformed through groups that deal with the knowledge that death is an awakening. The native extracts from the dark side to bring light.

- 9th house / / : Obsessions with freedom lead to searching, wandering, and to the lack of ties. The great transformation comes from knowing where one belongs. Lost in space and time, the native hunts for his spot which leads him through knowledge and education. In the group, one finds the ability to belong and take root.
- 10th house/ ♀ : Deep-rooted fears of failure drive the native to an overactive feeling of destiny. Transformation comes about through self-discipline in group activities. Identifying with the "good of the group" rather than the "the good of self" brings recognition and status to the native.
- 11th house/ ♂ : Freedom to be oneself is achieved when the unconscious fears of detachment are transmuted into awareness of truth. Detachment creates aloofness and produces a hermit. Freedom of self is achieved when one can identify with something and still maintain one's own identity. This is achieved within group activities designed to teach awareness of self.
- 12th house/ ✕ : Denial becomes an unconscious drive that can leave the native helpless. Understanding is reached when the native transforms his personal preoccupation with sorrow to involving himself with a group that lifts the pain of mankind up to God. Compassion is understanding each individual's needs, while not interfering with those needs.†

SUN SIGN BOOKSTORE

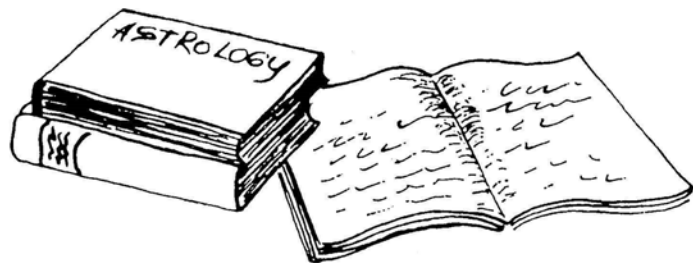

Fifth House

Sextiles

The Sextile represents a harmonious exchange of energy between two planets which are 60 degrees or two signs apart. This is one half of a trine by distance, however, not necessarily by interpretation. These two aspects (Δ *) are often combined in astrological textbooks as if they were the same because they are both "good" aspects. The trine indicates an almost effortless flow of energy between two planets usually in signs of the same element, while the sextile indicates a more stimulating exchange of energy between two planets in different but compatible elements. The signs involved in a sextile are usually both active (fire and air) or both passive (earth and water). The exceptions occur, as they do with all aspects, when

there is a dissociate or out-of-sign aspect. (Example: One planet in early degrees of Taurus can be sextile to another planet in late degrees of Gemini). This type of aspect is always weaker.

The sextile represents the basic principles of the Aries, first house of self-expression blended with the Gemini, third house of the conscious mind and communication, or the Aquarius, eleventh house of associations and goals. Both Gemini and Aquarius are air signs, so the natural influence of a sextile would be mentally and socially beneficial. There is also some element of the unusual or the unexpected in the sextile because of the Aquarius influence. If the sextile occurs in active or masculine signs, there is more of a desire to utilize the energy than when in passive or feminine signs.

One of the major differences between the trine and the sextile is that the trine brings benefits with no effort, while the sextile brings only the opportunities. Although the sextile does not promise as much as the trine, it is better in many ways as the individual is less likely to become lazy and self-indulgent.

Many musicians, artists, and performers have at least one sextile to Venus, which gives them the ability, opportunity, and desire to reach for success in a creative field. Neptune is very often the other planet involved in the sextile. Lucille Ball has a Venus/Neptune sextile with four other planets involved in two chains of sextiles. Most political leaders have a sextile to either Saturn or Jupiter, with Neptune being frequently involved as the other planet. It would be nice if only the highest idealistic nature of Neptune were being used here, unfortunately some of its negative, deceptive nature often occurs.

Since the basic influence of the sextile can be associated with the intellectual level of performance, then any sextile formed with Mercury would be of particular importance to the mental capacity. Any aspects between Mars, Mercury, and or Uranus tend to repeat the basic principles of the sextile, because of their relationship to the first, third, and eleventh houses. These sextiles will usually enhance the intellectual abilities.

Sextiles form links between houses offering opportunities for development and success. These links are formed by the planets in these houses, by the planets ruling these houses, or a combination of both. Between the second and fourth, these opportunities could involve finance and real estate, between the third and fifth, they could involve communication on a creative level such as writing or acting and between the eighth and tenth, they could involve a career in banking or accounting. Almost all horoscopes have at least one sextile, so don't overlook this aspect when searching for the door of opportunity.
